Forty-eight years after the birth of #3776, a new evolution is complete.

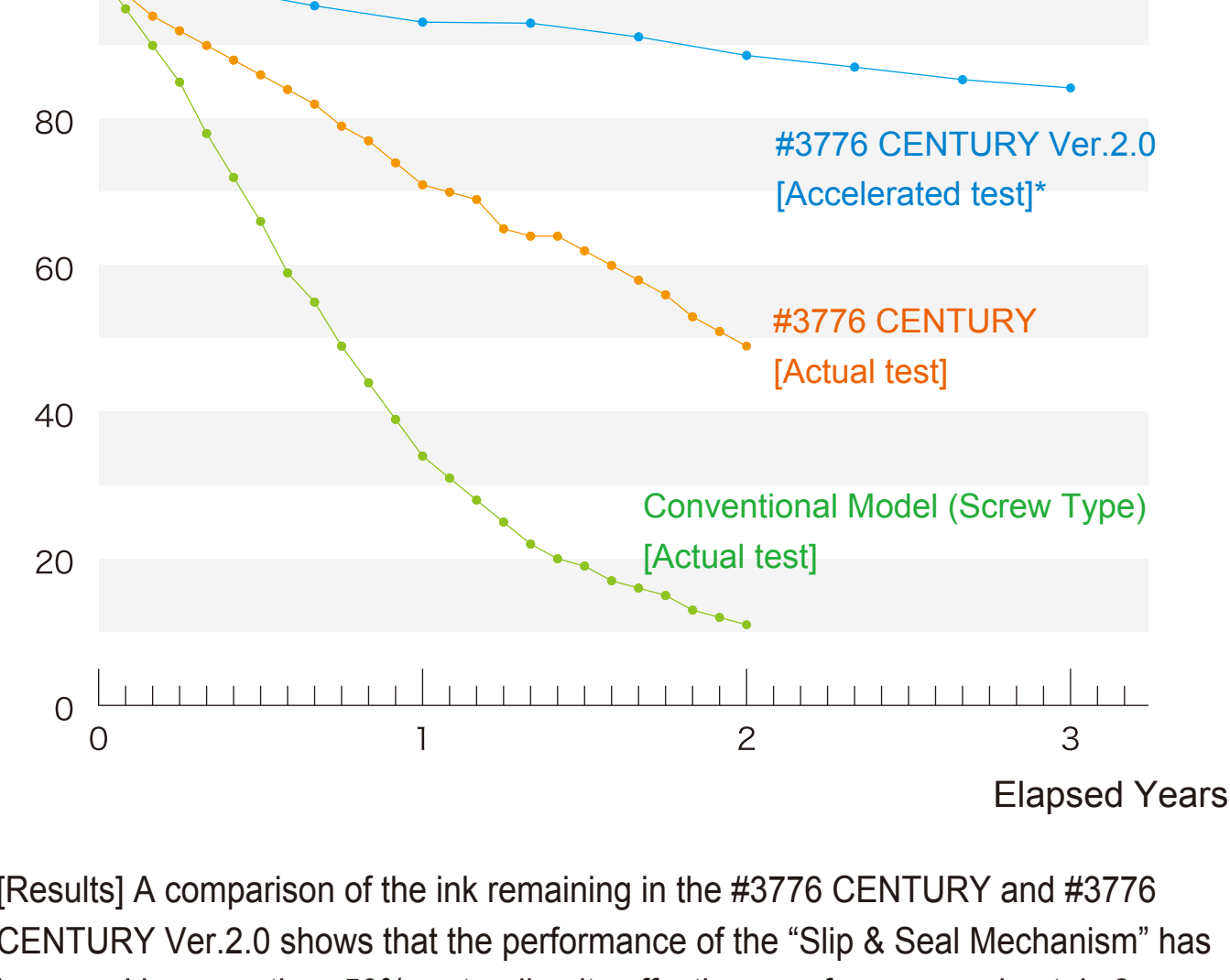


### Evolution of the Slip & Seal Mechanism

The improved “Slip & Seal Mechanism” has extended the airtight performance from about two years to over three years, allowing you to enjoy fresh ink longer than ever before.



### Ink Remaining Over Time



[Results] A comparison of the ink remaining in the #3776 CENTURY and #3776 CENTURY Ver.2.0 shows that the performance of the “Slip & Seal Mechanism” has improved by more than 50%, extending its effectiveness from approximately 2 years to over 3 years.

[Accelerated Test Method] A cartridge ink (Blue Black) was installed, and the pen was capped and placed horizontally in an environment at 50°C and 40% humidity for nine weeks. The weight was measured weekly. This nine-week accelerated test is equivalent to three years of actual use.

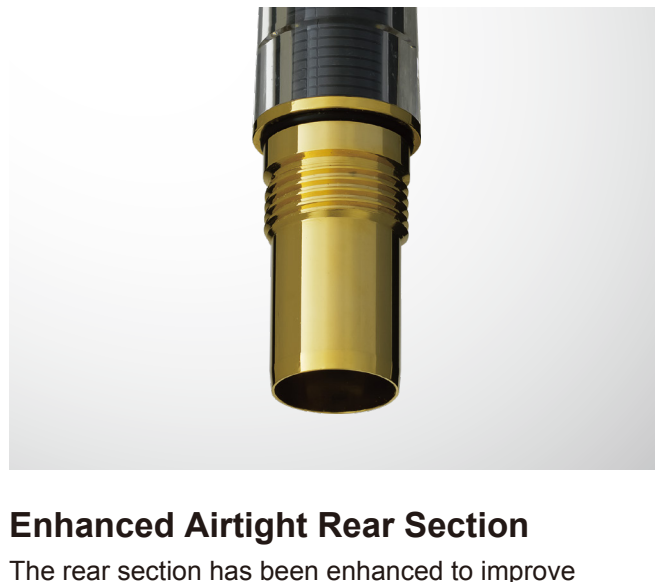
[Actual Test Method] A cartridge ink (Blue Black) was installed, and the pen was capped and stored horizontally at room temperature (in a cool, dark place). The weight was measured monthly to observe changes over time.

\*Results from the accelerated test may differ from those of the actual test.

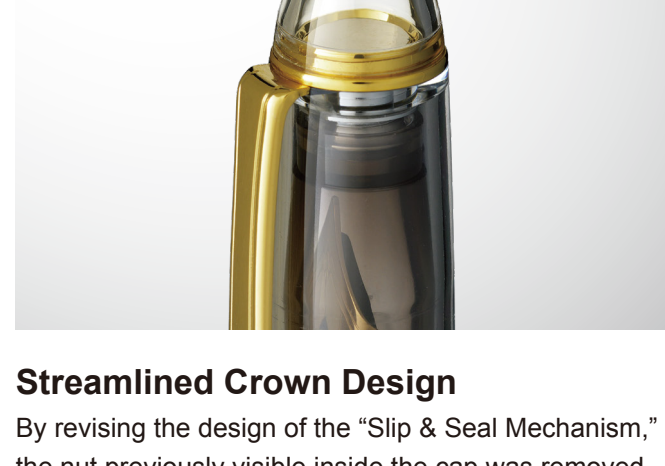
To prevent the ink from drying out, we reexamined every aspect of the design.



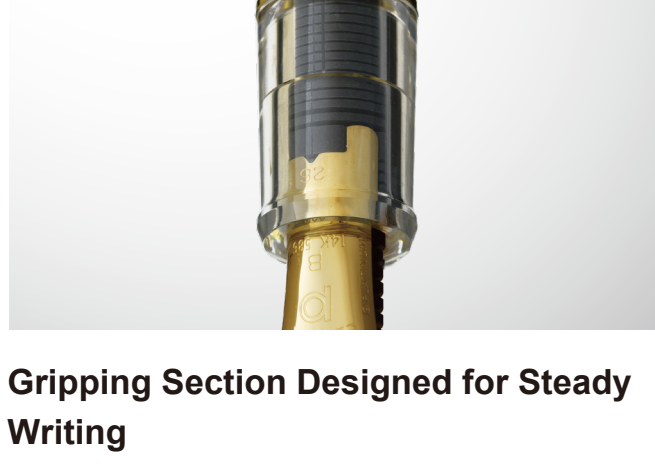
**Barrel with Improved Ink Visibility**  
To improve visibility of the ink, the internal surface was redesigned to be flat, reducing reflections and making it easier to check remaining ink levels.



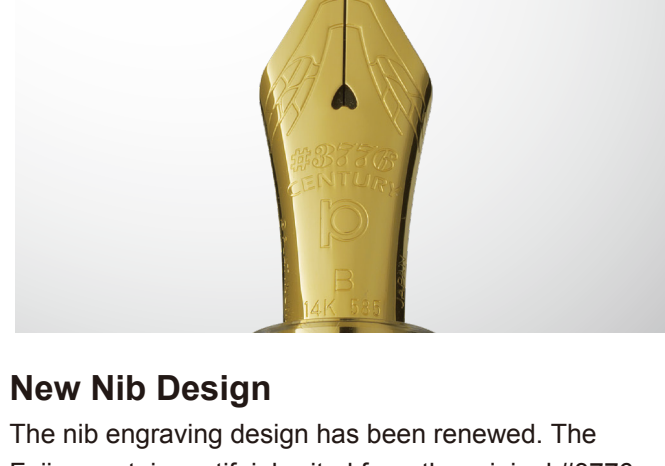
**Enhanced Airtight Rear Section**  
The rear section has been enhanced to improve airtightness, with a rubber ring added at the joint to reinforce the seal and prevent looseness during writing.



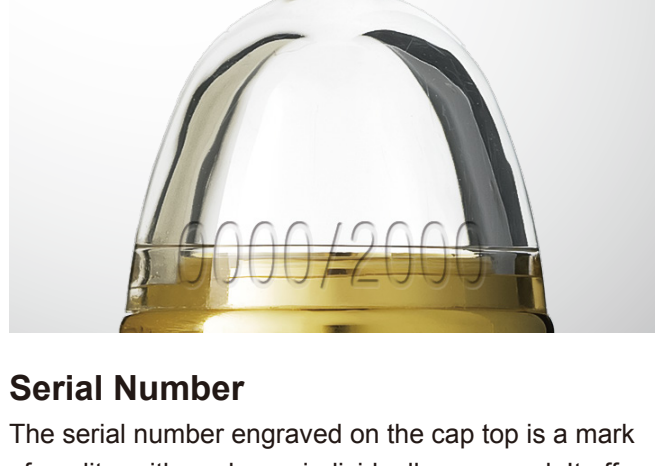
**Streamlined Crown Design**  
By revising the design of the “Slip & Seal Mechanism,” the nut previously visible inside the cap was removed, creating a clean, transparent space.



**Gripping Section Designed for Steady Writing**  
The grip structure has been redesigned, enhancing both durability and ease of maintenance, resulting in even more stable writing.

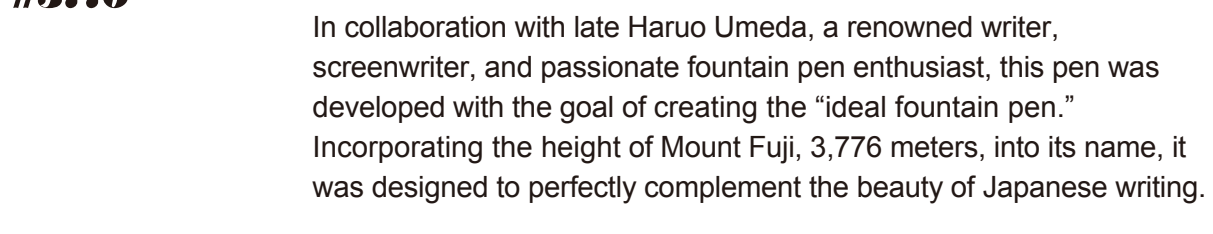


**New Nib Design**  
The nib engraving design has been renewed. The Fuji-mountain motif, inherited from the original #3776, has been refined into a contemporary expression, carrying forward its sense of trust and dignity while achieving a more polished and sophisticated look.

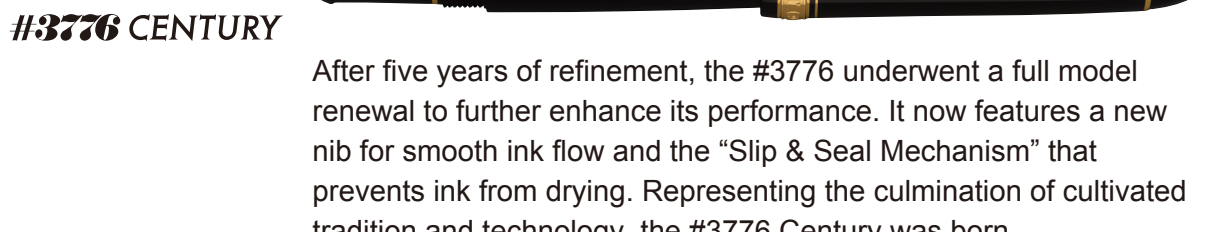


**Serial Number**  
The serial number engraved on the cap top is a mark of quality, with each pen individually managed. It offers a unique sense of exclusivity that you can truly appreciate.

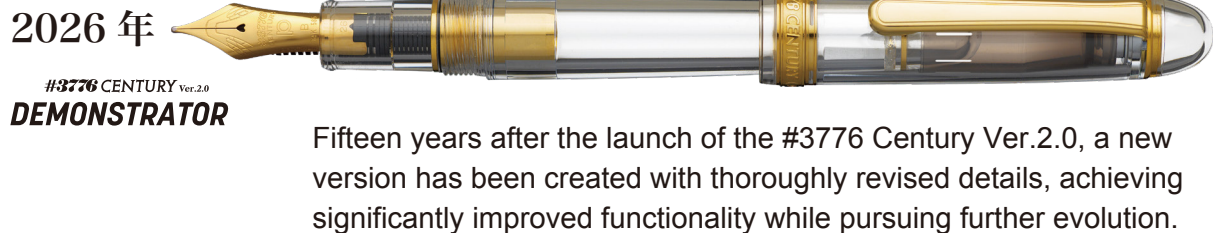
### The History of #3776

In collaboration with late Haruo Umeda, a renowned writer, screenwriter, and passionate fountain pen enthusiast, this pen was developed with the goal of creating the “ideal fountain pen.” Incorporating the height of Mount Fuji, 3,776 meters, into its name, it was designed to perfectly complement the beauty of Japanese writing.

After five years of refinement, the #3776 underwent a full model renewal to further enhance its performance. It now features a new nib for smooth ink flow and the “Slip & Seal Mechanism” that prevents ink from drying. Representing the culmination of cultivated tradition and technology, the #3776 Century was born.
